

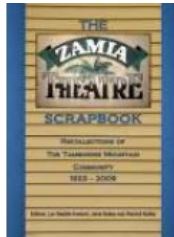

LIVE THEATRE AND MOVIES ON THE MOUNTAIN

We welcome you as a prospective new member of Tamborine Mountain Little Theatre Co Inc.. Tamborine Mountain Little Theatre is a 'Not for Profit Organization' formed over forty years ago.

Annual membership is **\$10** for the period 1 July - 30 June.

Subs can be posted to the Treasurer at TMLT, P.O. Box 352, North Tamborine, 4272 or by bank transfer (details on website). Monthly meetings are held on the first Tuesday of each month at 7.30 pm at the Zamia Theatre to which all members are invited. Our **Newsletter** is published monthly and is available to read on the TMLT website.

TMLT runs a Film Club and meetings are held at the Zamia Theatre on the third Sunday of every month at 5.30 pm where a chosen movie is screened. Films include Classic, Film Noir, Foreign Language, Musicals, and Comedy. Besides screening the movie, the club also has a social side to it, so if you want to bring along some nibbles and drinks, then that will certainly add to the club atmosphere. Of course, there is always tea and coffee available.

We have a committee of President, Vice - President, Secretary, Treasurer. Also five Life Members. The current committee members are specified in each Newsletter and also on the TMLT website. The committee is elected at each AGM, held the first Tuesday in September.

We aim to stage three major **Live Productions** each year as well as have play readings and rehearsed play readings. We are always on the lookout for people to direct plays but ask a budding director to direct a rehearsed play reading before taking on a major play. They can obtain a separate sheet outlining their responsibilities from the President or Secretary.

TMLT is the **Company in Residence** at the Zamia Theatre which is our usual venue for rehearsals, plays, movies and other events. TMLT is also the **managing company** for the hiring of the Zamia Theatre.

Auditions for major productions are advertised in the local papers, the website and Facebook site., and successful actors then have a commitment of at least two nights a week for about ten weeks of rehearsals. The plays are usually held on Friday and Saturday nights for three weeks with matinees on a Saturday or Sunday, and of course, there are the cast parties afterwards.

Writer's and Director's workshops are held occasionally and interested members are encouraged to join.

Helpers are always needed for productions. Some of the jobs involve lighting, sound, front of house duties, stage manager, costume making, set building etc. Specific requests are usually detailed in the Newsletter or you should make contact with the Director, President or Secretary if you can help during a particular production.

"Movies on the Mountain" is a regular event and a film is usually screened on the first Saturday of each month. On these occasions we also need help with selling tickets, raffles and refreshments. Volunteers get to see the movie for free!

We organise outings to other theatres and venues.

We welcome you and look forward to your joining in the fun and helping us bring professional community theatre to the Tamborine Mountain area.
